

FAQS FOR 2024 HOMESCHOOL CLASSES

PARKING

Houston Arboretum & Nature Center – 610 Entrance
120 W Loop N Freeway, Houston, TX 77024

Parking is free for members when you enter the parking code given with your membership into the ParkMobile/ParkHouston app or at the parking kiosks.

DROP OFF AND CLASS INFO

For safety reasons, students must be accompanied to check-in and be signed in by an adult. Children are not allowed to enter the property alone. There will be signs directing you to the sign-in which will be set up by the outside entrances to each classroom.

There will be four separate classrooms and separate sign-in sheets for each age group: 5-6's, 7-8's, 9-10's and 11-12's. Each class will have its own teacher and once signed in, parents are free to go. Parents and siblings are not allowed to join the class.

Class will begin promptly at 1pm on Mondays. Please allow plenty of time for parking and the short walk to the building.

WHAT TO BRING

Wear closed-toed shoes and comfortable play clothes that can get dirty during craft activities and outdoor hikes. Some activities may have specific needs, those will be emailed to you before your class/program.

Please bring:

- Refillable water bottle
- Sun/Rain protection (e.g. sunscreen, hat, sunglasses, rain jacket)

This is a two-hour class and there is no dedicated snack time so please make sure children have had lunch before class and are ready to learn.

MOSQUITOS

We will provide insect repellent with 25% DEET as the active ingredient. You are welcome to bring your own repellent with your child but please note that the [Centers for Disease Control](#)

does not recommend Citronella or other botanical repellents except for those containing oil of lemon eucalyptus.
